4	<p>Study Time:</p> <p><u>Seven subtle things that limits people in life: Part 7 – The sin of insecurity</u> Scripture Reading: Judges 6:11-16; Romans 8:33-39</p> <p>This is the final week of our study on the subtle things that limit people in life. Of all the subtle things that limit people in life, insecurity ranks as one of the highest of them. Insecurity is so subtle and hard to spot because it lies beneath the surface, influencing our thoughts and actions on a daily basis without us noticing it. Insecurity is so powerful that it can impact our entire life, how we relate to others and how we respond to God’s call on our lives.</p> <p>Insecurity is a feeling of inadequacy, always feeling like you are never good enough. It is a feeling of low self-worth. Insecurity is the absence of a feeling of security, the lack of a feeling of protection.</p> <p>Insecurity weighs us down and identifying the causes is the first step in being free from it. What are causes of insecurity? (Please read the scriptures below and discuss the points listed)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Feelings of inadequacy due to past failures.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Luke 15: 11-24 <p>How can we overcome insecurity in our lives??</p> <p>Insecurity weighs people down in life; however, it can be conquered. Below are some keys that will help us do that.</p> <p>1. Acknowledge your feelings of insecurity.</p> <p>2. Identify the root cause of your insecurity and ask the Lord to help you overcome it.</p> <p>3. Change your focus. Choose to focus on the positives qualities in your life.</p> <p> From the message on Wednesday, what are five results of insecurity?</p> <p> What are the signs that can show you are insecure as a person?</p>
